

Procedure for Recreational Flying at Fairoaks

Since the resumption of recreational flying the airport management have been keeping the situation under review and have gradually been reducing the restrictions which are in place with the aim of returning to normal operations as soon as it became viable and safe to do so. That time has come.

The FISOs have now had the opportunity to get back “up to speed” therefore with the one exception below we are now returning to normal operations. With immediate effect, PPR by telephone is no longer required except for flights on Sundays prior to 10am and after 8pm.

The sole exception to normal operations is that pilots must not visit the tower since the layout within the tower does not permit social distancing to be observed when visitors are present. Payments for fuel and landing fees can either be made at the bowser or by telephone to 01276 857300 or 01276 857700.
