Based upon the Roadmap and guidance the following shall apply at Fairoaks.

Up to and including 11th April 2021

- All flights shall be strictly PPR by telephone.
- At times when no flights are booked the Air Traffic Service Unit (ATSU) may close for short periods.

Effective 12th April 2021

- The requirement for PPR by telephone shall be removed.
- The ATSU shall be open throughout the normal airport operating hours.

Caveats

- It must be noted that these dates could change if the government delays implementation of Stage 2 of the Roadmap.
- Fairoaks Airport is not able to monitor individual flights therefore **Pilots and operators are responsible for ensuring that any flight which is undertaken complies with the COVID-19 restrictions which apply at the time of the flight.**
